OBJECTIVES

The project “Che Genere di Europa?” aims to strengthen civic participation, European awareness and social inclusion through two closely interlinked operational axes: the “Citizens’ Europe Table” and the “Che Genere di Europa?” Festival. Both initiatives seek to create spaces and opportunities for discussion on the founding values of the European Union, active citizenship and civil rights, combining educational, cultural and artistic dimensions.

The European Round Table is a permanent structure for discussion and territorial coordination, divided into three tables, aimed respectively at schools and educational institutions, associations and citizens. Alongside the Round Table, the “Che Genere di Europa?” Festival aims to raise awareness among the population about the founding values of the European Union over two days. With a calendar of screenings, talks and debates, the festival promotes European citizenship with a particular focus on gender equality and inclusion, using cinema as a tool for empowerment and storytelling.

ACTIVITIES

- **Coordination table for schools and educational institutions:** brings together Erasmus representatives from secondary schools, technical institutes, universities and ITS (technical colleges) in quarterly meetings to share best practices and collaborations on exchange opportunities offered by the EU.

- **Associations table:** an opportunity for workshop training on EU project management, EU programmes and international partnership management.

- **Meetings for citizens:** open to all, raising awareness of EU opportunities through interactive workshops and digital materials.

- **“Che Genere di Europa?” festival:** two days exploring the founding values of the EU, with film screenings, theatre workshops and art installations, focusing on gender inequality.

EXPECTED RESULTS

The project will activate and consolidate a stable network of educational institutions coordinated with each other for the design of internationalisation initiatives and the promotion of European exchanges.

In addition, it will promote the growth of project skills in at least 10 associations through training courses, mentoring and project simulations.

The European Theatre and Film Festival will stimulate reflection on European values through artistic, intercultural and inclusive languages.
